Privacy Policy

Luxembourg Tech School (LTS) asbl ("us", "we" or "our") operates educational classroom

classes in modules, workshops, online courses, events, projects and challenges (hereinafter

referred to as the "Service").

We aim to be completely transparent with how we collect and use personal information we

gather about our users. Our users' privacy is important to us and we will protect and respect

the personal information of all users who use or access our Service. This document informs

How does LTS asbl control and process the data?

We are the Data Controller, as we determine the means and/or purposes of the personal

information processing. Simultaneously, we are a Data Processor, as we carry out personal

information processing tasks, in order to accomplish our purposes.
