Information collected

If you contact us for a support request or for courses and events registration, we collect the following categories of data:

- Personal identification data: first name, last name, parent's or representative name, e-mail address, age, gender, school name.
- Other kind of data such emergency contact details and food allergies in case of needed.

If you contact us as part of a commercial relationship, we collect the following categories of data:

- Personal identification data (e.g., name, address, phone number).
- Economic and financial data: occupation, bank account details, tax situation.

In addition, LTS does not collect any information automatically, the main communication tool is Microsoft Teams which is provided under the Microsoft Office 365 license managed by the Luxembourg Centre de Gestion informatique de l'éducation: <u>https://portal.education.lu/cgie/</u>GDPR compliance <u>https://portal.education.lu/cgie/SERVICES/GDPR/GDPR-FAQ.</u>

For mandatory and optional software tools and online services (listed in Appendix 1), which required user registration, possible actions for students under 16 years old are indicated.

Purposes and Legal Basis

LTS collects and processes Client's personal data to provide the services and maintain the relationship. Legal basis is performance of the contract. GDPR (art. 6.1.b)

LTS collects and processes users' personal data such in the framework of the participation in its program, delivery of the content and analyses of its activities. By using or accessing the Service in any manner, you agree to the collection and the use of your information regarding your child. Legal basis is consent. GDPR (art. 6.1.a)

LTS also collects and processes your personal data in the framework of your registration to the Events and workshops organized by LTS. Legal basis is consent (art. 6.1.a)

We also process the identification and contact data that the user provides through the contact form on the website, or when contacting the Responsible by email, as well as other data that the user includes. The data processing is based on the acceptance and consent of the interested party: in those cases where to make a request it is necessary to fill in a form and make a "click" on the send button, the realization of the same will necessarily imply that the user has been informed and has expressly granted his consent to the processing of his data based on this privacy notice.

When you visit our website, we store certain information about the browser and operating system you use, the access status (e.g., whether you were able to access a website or received an error message), the search terms you may have entered. We also store your IP address for security reasons. We use the personal data collected when you visit our website to operate it in the most convenient manner for your use and to protect our IT systems from attacks and other illegal activities. Legal basis is legitimate interest (GDPR, art. 6.1.f)

Retention Period

We will store personal information for as long as the user uses our Service. For inactive users during a period of 6 months, their information will be deleted, excluding education records and certificates. Once the course has finished, the User Accounts must be deleted by the User.

Personal data transfer to third parties

We can also provide some information to external service providers whose participation is necessary for the provision of services to clients, such as lawyers, third-party technical service providers etc.

These recipients of Personal Data may act as Data Controllers or processors and must comply with the legal and/or contractual obligations regarding the protection of Personal Data, including applicable processor contractual clauses (in case of processors), confidentiality obligations.

Recipients

We can provide your personal data to other recipients if required to meet our contractual and legal obligations. These can include:

- Official authorities such the Ministry of Education to create the account numbers for the programs.

Your Rights

You have the right to request:

- Right to restriction of processing: you have the right to obtain the restriction of specific personal data processing when one of the following applies:
 - When you have contested the accuracy of your personal data, for a period enabling us to verify the accuracy of the personal data,
 - If your personal data have been processed by us in an unlawful way and you oppose their erasure.
 - We no longer need your personal data, but they are required by you for the establishment, exercise, or defence of legal claims.
 - When you have exercised your right to object, for a period enabling us to verify whether our legitimate interests override yours.
- Right to data portability: you have the right to receive personal data that you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and to transmit these data to another controller. However, when the personal data are not processed by automated means, you do not fulfil the conditions to exercise your right to portability.
- Right to object: you have the right to object at any time, on grounds related to your particular situation, to any processing of your personal data necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or based on legitimate interest.
